The Lassen County Incident Command (IC) for COVID-19 would like to inform the public that an Incident Command Structure (ICS) has been established to coordinate the local response to the COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) pandemic. Barbara Longo, Director for Health and Social Services for Lassen County, and Sheriff Dean Growdon will provide leadership to the ICS as the joint Incident Commanders.

The Incident Command is a multi-agency response, including state and local agencies. The Incident Commanders are committed to bringing timely, accurate, and complete information to the public. Richard Egan, Lassen County CAO, serves as the Public Information Officer (PIO) and Officer Kristen Wilburn, California Highway Patrol, serves as his deputy PIO for this incident.

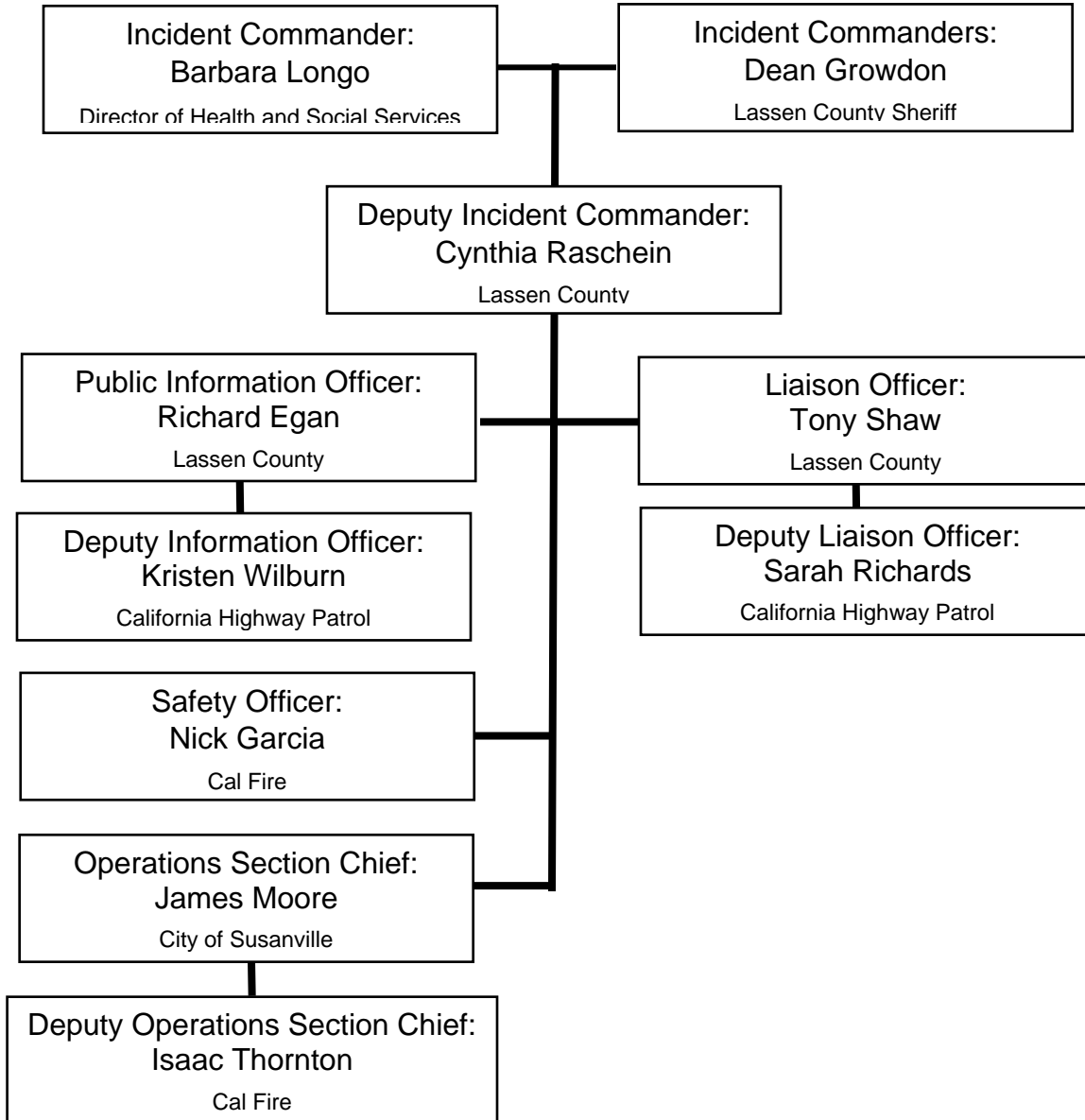
